Discussion Topics/ Presentations</b>	<p>Open discussion among members about challenges and successes occurring within current environment included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The System of Care/Child and Family Team training website, which was created by the NC State Collaborative's Training and TA committee went live on October 1, 2010. It has already received 500+ visitors.</b></li> <li>• Paul Savery manages list-serves addressing Adolescent Co-Occuring Disorders and Latino Issues. If interested in being added please contact Paul Savery with DMH/DD/SA.</li> <li>• Widespread concern about additional impending budget cuts</li> <li>• Some optimism about federal funding connected to health reform, such as that for school-based health clinics</li> <li>• DSS is working with a technical advisor on making the best use of complex funding streams</li> <li>• Cynthia Daniels-Hall is working now on helping families with private medical insurance and children with special health needs to pay for care when their insurance runs out</li> <li>• Local backlash against the DMHDDSAS Critical Access Behavioral Health Agency definition, which is forcing many small providers out of business</li> <li>• Katie Tise described several initiatives Center for Child &amp; Family Health, which provides trauma-informed therapy for children as well as trains therapists around the state on evidence-based practices in this area. She also noted exemplary child-centered practices within the Durham Police Department, such as immediate notification of the Center for Child &amp; Family Health when children have been involved in traumatic incidents and leadership support to respond with remarkable flexibility to family needs after such incidents.</li> </ul> <p><b>3b.
