Review of current fiscal year strategic priorities SC Members reviewed the first priority of the strategic priorities as it related to the engagement of local collaborative.</li> <li>2. Linking with local collaborative Rebecca and Libby sent an outreach letter to local collaborative a few months ago. They heard from numerous local collaborative interested in having State Collaborative speakers come to their local collaboratives. Some SC Members volunteered to visit these sites and will work-out details off-line with Libby and Rebecca.</li> </ol> <p>Libby and Rebecca intend to send communication regularly to community collaboratives. It was brought to the Collaborative's attention that some of the email addresses may not be comprehensive; addresses will be double checked. Family partner coordinators and SOC coordinators will also be added to the list, to help ensure all local collaborative are hearing from the State Collaborative.</p> <p>State Collaborative will gradually begin to add other local collaborative to their outreach distribution list. Collaboratives to be added are the Juvenile Crime Prevention Council, School Health Advisory Councils, Community Child Protect Teams (Rick Zechman will follow-up with Phyllis Horton and invite her to a meeting), Healthy Carolinian Initiatives, Innovative Approach, Youth Risk Behavior Survey (Durham), Adolescent Health Commission (Durham), CARMET (Durham). Addition of these collaborative is to be as inclusive as possible and address youth needs from a multi-disciplinary perspective.</p> <p>Initiatives that the State Collaborative may take-up to make meetings and State Collaborative information more accessible. Some suggestions were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>--get collaborative website on other related websites,</li> <li>--include local collaborative information on State Collaborative website (either URL or contact information)</li> <li>--create newsletter for local collaborative to pass around</li> <li>--video or recordings of State Collaborative meeting minutes accessible by website</li> <li>-- add pics of State Collaborative's Members to website, with name and email on website</li> </ul> <p>Erin will list attending member organizations in Reminder emails with summary of meeting minutes in the body of email, add link for State Collaborative website in body of email, provide Damie (website manager) with links and handouts from recent SC meetings for addition to website, provide parking information and map in meeting reminder email.</p> <p>Last month, those present both expressed gratitude to the National Center for Child Traumatic Stress for hosting our meetings and noted concerns about travel restrictions impeding participation for some Raleigh-based participants.
