The Child Advocates work as Ombudsman for youth in need of assistance getting services. To take action on this issue contact your General Assembly Legislator. Click the link to locate your local representatives: http://capwiz.com/cdpmi/home/</p> <p>The Collaborative reaffirmed a previous decision to list the Child and Family Team/System of Care trainers in NC with contact information rather than list dates of specific trainings.</p> <p>The Collaborative completed review of Priority #3 of its current strategic priorities– using data to inform decisions about practices and programs.</p> <p>At the first meeting in March, Members will be asked to recommend websites addressing “research and practices that are working for family and youth”. Rebecca Wells also requested that people email the links to her at rwells@unc.edu for easier compilation. Rebecca will then send these links to Damie Jackson-Diop to post on the Collaborative website.</p> <p>Damie Jackson-Diop requested \$1,003 to pay for transportation for students from Cleveland County to participate in North Carolina Families United's Leadership Program. Heather Reynolds said this district might have DPI funds they could use for this purpose. Decision was tabled pending information about availability of DPI funds and the Collaborative's account balance.</p>
