The group discussed the potential for people to misconstrue data that sometimes reflect reporting idiosyncrasies.</p> <p>We discussed how to structure the next several meetings, conferring with staff about how to proceed with any individuals from their respective agencies.</p> <p>We discussed priorities #2, supporting implementation of child and family teams, and #3, renamed to “Data Driven Decision Making Based on Outcomes and Data Sharing.”</p> <p><b>Alexandra Sirota</b> shared that the Data Advisory Council she leads has been working on identifying common measures of child, family, and community well-being and accessing the relevant data from different service sectors. Her workgroup will provide quarterly updates to Collaborative with opportunities for feedback.</p> <p><b>Lana Dial</b> expressed interest in documenting the evolution of Child and Family Teams and examining best practices in this model.
