Brings together a network of service agencies and public officials to support families where one or more of the parents or caregivers have issues with substance abuse. Intent is to improve collaborations between child welfare &amp; substance abuse service providers in order to improve the safety, permanency &amp; well being of children and their families.</p> <p>In NC, there are 21 statewide programs /10 residential maternal &amp; perinatal substance abuse treatment programs as well as 9 CASAWORKS programs. <b>1-800-FOR-BABY</b> to access these programs. Treatment Alternative to Street Crime (TASK) is another means of communicating to the courts.</p> <p>“Seeking Safety” was mentioned as a program that addresses mental health and substance abuse treatment simultaneously. Duke Family Care also does dual diagnosis treatment.</p> <p>Disproportionality: an over or under representation in regards to a referenced population. Disparity: comparison of one group to another in terms of services, outcomes, disproportionality</p> <p>In NC there is a 2.08 disparity rate for black children vs white children, meaning black children are 2.08 times more likely to be in foster care than white children. In relation to other states (NY 7.11 : IL 7.11 CA 5.40 &amp; US 3.32. disparity rates)</p> <p>HB 231 and SB363 pending which would add 3 PBS positions at DPI</p> <p>Meck Cares grant federal SAMHSA review and given great review, but fiscal downturn could impact community matching funds Meck Care receives.</p> <p>NC Families United newsletter to publish SOC – like activities</p> <p>Joel shared that a presentation was made to state legislators on Child Welfare</p> <p>Bill pending to move Smart Start out of DPI's Office of School Readiness thereby eliminating the office</p>	<p>Info will be posted on the NC Collaborative website.</p> <p><a href="http://ssw.unc.edu/cw">http://ssw.unc.edu/cw</a></p>
