Agenda Items for Future Meetings</p>	<p>Dr. Joel Rosch with the Terry Sanford Center For Child and Family Policy, Duke University jbrrosch@duke.edu presented up to date information on Evidenced Based Programs Joel discussed where the idea of evidenced based programs originated, why such practices are being promoted and in place, how EBPs are determined to work and with what assurance with specific groups of children or adults, and the impact on services provided across all levels of implementation (recipient, family/community, systems – local, state and federal). An advantage of the Science based approach is that defines goals upfront and more clearly defines the measures for the outcomes desired. Information relevant for application in NC was provided. Joel offered suggestions for ‘sizing’ up how well people are doing in implementing a best practice. He recommended checking the lists of approved practices and programs that have met the research compliance for effectiveness; Finding an EBP that most approximates what you do; and then asking...How close are you to what they do?; If you are purchasing training, why not get something that will work?</p> <p>In addition the following web sites were among the resource information provided.
