1. Welcome & Introductions	Approved.
2. Approval of minutes from 8-13-2010 meetings	<p>Members present agreed to pay an as yet unspecified individual to provide the following support functions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taking notes during meetings; revising with input from co-chairs and speakers and any later corrections from other participants • Updating list of SC participants used for minutes • Following up via email with speakers and co-chairs to review for accuracy • Emailing minutes to listserv with agenda for next meeting • Emailing to web site manager after approval • Maintaining SC calendar on web site/Google docs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Noting when meeting facilities are available ○ Communicating with host organization about meeting facilities • Communicating with speakers about logistics • List serve management [subsequently removed, as Susan Robinson is game to continue in this function] <p>In keeping with compensation for family representatives, we will pay \$25/hour for 4-8 hours per month, not including travel to and from meetings.</p> <p>Rebecca asked the group to consider making 1 time \$500 payment to NCFU for additional staff time associated with website upgrade during 2010. The group decided to wait for a report on expenditures from NCFU and for the transfer of funds from the UNC account to NCFU.</p>
3a. Discussion Topics/ Presentations	<p>Dorothy Best noted that the NC Mental Health Consumers Organization is making progress on a youth leadership series.</p> <p>NC Mental Health Association: We discussed who might know of job opportunities for displaced MHA staff. Sherry Stafford said that icare will have positions when their new grant starts, which will be posted at icarenc.org. Kimberley Blackshear noted that the National Center on Child Traumatic Stress will need statisticians and other people with related skills to complete newly funded additional analyses on data from children served by Network members.</p> <p>Jennifer Rothman of NAMI will share information on Collaborative activities with the DMHDDSAS Coalition.</p> <p>We agreed to meet at the National Child Traumatic Stress Network's training room for the next 6 months and see how that worked for them and for the Collaborative. This selection was based on improved accessibility for participants coming from the south and west; improved access to Duke and UNC resources (students, research and evaluation presentations); internet access; projecting capability [with advance notice]; and a food service area on a lower level. This space also has ample free parking space. The NCPA has been a generous host, upon whom we may call again if, for instance, the Durham meeting is too problematic for Raleigh participants.</p>
