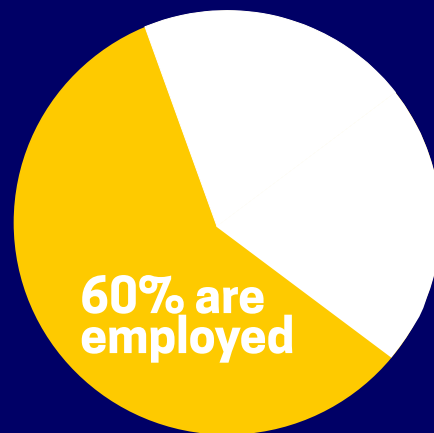
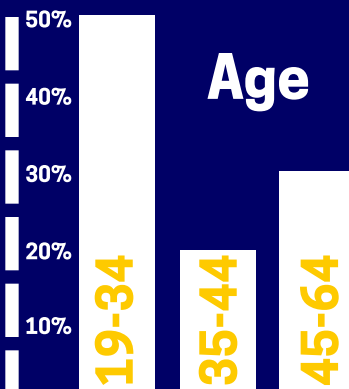

Medicaid Expansion Benefits

- Creates an estimated 40,000 jobs
- Brings in \$13 billion federal funds over a decade
- Reduces the number of children in Foster Care
- Increases access to care and decreases emergency room visits
- Reduces the number of people incarcerated for a health disorder

Who pays for the Expansion?

Federal funds pay

\$0.90

of every dollar spent on services

North Carolina hospitals have agreed to pay the remaining

\$0.10
