**Senate Budget:** Rumors are that the Senate budget will come out in June and that the Senate will not try to pass it right away. In fact, we have heard they may even recess until later in the summer. The budget that is currently in place will remain effective until the General Assembly passes another budget for the biennium. If the delay occurs, it may be because the budget process is more difficult now that neither the House nor the Senate have the super majority. This means that the House and the Senate not only have to compromise on a budget amongst themselves, but they also have to send a budget to the Governor that he will not veto.

**Crossover Outcome:** Bills that are related to appropriations did not have to meet the crossover deadline. Below is the tentative outcome of the crossover deadline for bills that we have been tracking. Although a bill may not meet the traditional criteria for crossover, if there is a will to keep it under consideration, that could still be accomplished. One way is to include bill language as a special provision of the budget. Some bills have been included in the House budget and some may be included in the Senate budget.
